



*Rights over the land*

A Forest Management Agreement (FMA) is a 20-year agreement between the Province of Alberta, as represented by the Minister of Sustainable Resource Development and Spray Lake Sawmills (1980) Ltd. It receives approval through an Order in Council and is signed off by the Minister of Sustainable Resource Development, the Lieutenant Governor in Council and Spray Lake Sawmills.

The company has rights, which allow it to enter upon the land for the primary purpose of growing and harvesting timber. This allows Spray Lake Sawmills to invest in timber inventories and long range planning in addition to our operational activities. The Minister reserves all land rights not specifically granted to the company. This includes such things as wildlife management, recreational use, oil and gas activity, grazing and trapping.
