



*How will an FMA affect
other resource values?*

The Forest Management Agreement (FMA) area is Crown land. The province will plan, manage and administer other resource activities in the same manner as it always has. This includes both commercial and non-commercial activities. The company's management of the FMA for timber does not preclude the right of others to travel, hunt, fish, or otherwise use the area for recreational purposes.

Other resource values have been recognized through the various integrated resource management plans, which cover the area. Spray Lake Sawmills will be working on a detailed forest management plan for the FMA. This plan will ensure consistency with the higher level integrated resource management plans and include a public involvement process.

Planning for timber values cannot be done in isolation of the other resource values on the landscape. A cooperative, integrated approach to planning is critical to long term harmonization.
