



Regulated practice

Forest management is a highly regulated and controlled field of practice. There are numerous acts and regulations, which govern practice within the forest industry; the Forest Act and the Timber Management Regulation being the two primary documents. In addition, there are provincial policy documents, which touch on almost every facet of forest management. The provincial Timber Harvest Planning and Operating Ground Rules is a key document in this regard.

Once plans are prepared they are submitted to the Crown for review and approval. The Forest Service (Land and Forest Division) acts as the intermediary for this process; bringing together input from several different provincial government agencies. After the appropriate approvals are received and field operations commence, inspections are carried out to ensure compliance.
