



What is an FMA?

FMA stands for Forest Management Agreement. It is an agreement between the provincial government and a forest products company, which provides the company with certain rights over a defined landbase for the purposes of growing and harvesting timber on a sustained yield basis.

Spray Lake Sawmills (1980) Ltd recently converted most of its timber quota cutting rights into an FMA.

What affect will this have on the area's forests and how will other forest values and land use activities be impacted?
